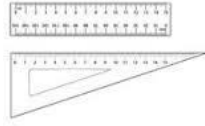

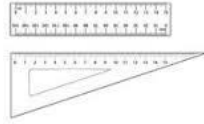

### **Workshop 4 - VAL and Employee Supported Volunteering**

VAL hold an annual contract with George at ASDA to support their employees to volunteer. This takes the form of one-off volunteering days and recently included supporting the elderly in sheltered housing to make Christmas decorations and carol singing. VAL's role includes searching for and working with organisations to create volunteering days. This workshop will help you as an organisation identify how you can attract businesses to volunteer with you and give you an insight into the role VAL can play to help facilitate this.
